LOCK IN YOUR EVENT



STEP 1

Lock in your Colour Challenge! Tell us your preferred date and time and the package you would like to proceed with

STEP 2

Set up your ticketing system. Some schools have an online portal where an item can be created. You can also choose to use a ticketing platform such as TryBooking or EventBrite, however these do add a ticketing fee



STEP 3

Start promoting! Operation Flinders will send you your Colour Challenge templates and posters to print or include in your newsletter.

STEP 4

Send Operation Flinders your students summary including t-shirt sizing and quantities so we can prepare all items for your event

If your school is hosting an Ultimate Colour or Colour Blast Challenge, Operation Flinders will do a site visit to ensure we have access to water and electricity. We may also require vehicle access directly to the oval.

Dates for 2024 have already started to be booked so make sure you lock in your event as soon as possible!

NO TARGETS

Operation Flinders Foundation does not require additional fundraising target to be reached for each event. There is no obligation to fundraise on top of the fee per student.

WHERE THE FUNDS GO

Funds from the Colour Challenges will go directly towards Operation Flinders Exercise expenses.

An example of the items we will be able to purchase thanks to events such as these are:

- Hiking boots
- Sleeping bags
- Food / rations
- Participant awards such as dog tags and boomerangs
- Packs
- Hutchies (tarps to sleep under)

POST-EVENT

Once your event has concluded, Operation Flinders Foundation will invoice the school the donation amount for the Colour Challenge.
